December 11, 2023

The meeting was called to order at 5:02 pm by Doug Reardon of Greenville. By order of roll call vote, in attendance were Bill Ezell and Ken Caisse of Temple, Doug Reardon of Greenville, Chief McTague and Deb Morrison.

Minutes

Ken made a motion to accept the minutes for the October 2, 2023 meeting and Doug seconded. Motion passed.

Old Business

There was no old business to discuss.

New Business

The upcoming 2024 budget was discussed at length with Greenville Town Administrator Tara Sousa explaining the need for some changes in the preliminary budget. It was decided to send out the modified budget to the Joint Board again with the decision to approve it at the January board meeting.

There was again some discussion on speed signs in Temple.

Chief's Report

The Chief would like to increase the detail rate to \$85. Doug made a motion to increase that line item, Ken seconded and the motion passed.

Motion to enter non-public session made by Doug Reardon, seconded by Bill Ezell by reason of: RSA 91-A:3, II (c) *Matters which, if discussed in public, would likely affect adversely the reputation of any person, other than a member of this board, unless such person requests an open meeting. This exemption shall extend to include any application for assistance or tax abatement or waiver of a fee, fine or other levy, if based on inability to pay or poverty of the applicant.*

Roll call vote to enter non-public session: Doug Reardon – aye, Bill Ezell – aye, Ken Caisse – aye. Entered non-public session at 5:19 pm.

Motion to return to public session made by Doug Reardon and was returned at 5:23 pm.

Motion made from Doug Reardon, seconded by Bill Ezell, to seal the minutes because it is determined that divulgence of this information likely would affect

- adversely the reputation of any person other than a member of this board
- render a proposed action ineffective
- pertains to preparation or carrying out of actions regarding terrorism.

Roll call vote to seal the minutes Doug Reardon – aye, Bill Ezell – aye, Ken Caisse – aye.

Chief made a point regarding the animal control officers in that they do not work for the police department and is not responsible for their personnel, etc. They have been permitted to use the PD address and phone number. Request for assistance or service by animal control is then forwarded by the PD to them.

The next meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, January 2, at 5:00 pm in Temple. Doug made a motion to adjourn and Bill seconded. All in favor to adjourn and the meeting ended at 5:31 pm.
