## Meeting Notes for the December 20 Renewable Energy Task Force Meeting

The meeting was called to order by Rob Wills at 7:07 PM.

Attendees were committee members- Rob Wills, Deb Deleso and Bev Edwards (remotely).

We reviewed the following steps we had taken toward the establishment of a Community Power Plan for Temple:

- 1. On Oct 24 Rob Wills attended a Selectboard meeting to ask for the approval of a Joint Powers Agreement for Community Power.
- 2. The town lawyer reviewed the Joint Powers Agreement and approved it.
- 3. At that point, the approval of all Selectboard members followed suit.
- 4. The Selectboard further appointed the Renewable Energy Task force committee to be the Temple Community Power Committee and to continue taking the required next steps for the establishment of a Community Power initiative for Temple, as follows:
- Rob Wills and Bev Edwards are appointed as representatives to the PUC for Temple. They require 2 representatives. Deb Deleso will be back-up.
- We received a signed copy of the Joint Powers Agreement and sent it to the PUC.
- CENH registered Temple Community Power with the PUC.
- Add in goals and objectives to the Electric Aggregation Community Power Plan
- We conducted two public hearings to review Community Power- CENH provided help with materials and provided the power point presentations.
- Next steps for Temple Community Power are:

- To create a warrant article for Town Meeting using the CENH template

- We will work on the Electric Aggregation plan for Temple, based on the NH Community Power organization template and provide it on the Temple web site.
